☺ **RULES and INFORMATION**

- **Lesson:** 7:30 – 8:30 am > (8th – 12th grade, boys & girls).
- **Lesson:** 8:30 – 9:30 am > (5th – 7th grade, boys & girls).
- **Lesson:** 9:30 – 10:30 am > (K – 4th grade, boys & girls).
- **All junior golfers will get to hit golf balls during their lesson times!**
- All junior golfers should play at least a few holes of golf after their respective lessons.
- **Soft spike golf shoes or tennis shoes are the preferred footwear.**
- **NO metal spikes allowed on the golf course!**
- Older players (grades 7-12) will be allowed to play unsupervised.
- Younger players (grades K-6) shall have an adult with each group.
- Non-member juniors may play **on the front nine only**, up until the outing starts, at no charge,
- **NO** junior play on the back nine due to regular golfer play. Club outings may limit Monday play.
- **Proper behavior is expected of all junior golfers while on the golf course and in the clubhouse.**
