# 8-Person One Club Alternate Shot

Saturday, June 20 / Tee Times start at 3:00 / 18 Holes

**ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per person**

**TEAM FORMAT:** 8-person alternate shot

**FORMAT REQUIREMENTS:** The 8 player team must rank each player as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

Player #1 tees off on hole #1 and one ball is alternated for the entire 18 holes. Each player must hit in the proper order as they were designated. If player #5 holes out on hole #1 then player #6 must tee off on hole #2. Each of the eight players ***MUST*** pre-select a club that they will use and they must use only that club when it is their turn to hit, no matter where they are hitting from. This is what makes this format fun and exciting. **Sign up on the bulletin board by Friday, June 19 as a team or an individual.**
