Women's & Men's Day Rules

TUESDAY – LADIES DAY: The first tee will be reserved for morning Ladies League activities from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m., May through September and for the Evening Ladies League play from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m., May through August. Both leagues have the right to close the entire course for special events. Play on the back nine will be allowed provided there is no cross over interference from front nine play and a significant distance is established from Ladies League play.

Note: The Evening Ladies League starts play on the back nine on the last Tuesday of each month from May through August.

THURSDAY – MEN'S DAY: From May 1st through September 30th, Ladies are allowed morning play only. Ladies tee times should be scheduled to insure that play is completed on the front by 11:00 a.m. and all ladies shall be completely off the golf course by 1:00 p.m. The entire course may be closed for special men's events. **Exception:** Ladies may be allowed on the course after the times mentioned above, as *spectators only* to watch club sanctioned events.

Scramble “Mulligan” Golf (Friday afternoon event)

Event Format: Two person scramble. Each 2-person team gets **one mulligan per hole**. Can be used for any shot whether it is a drive, iron or chip shot or a putt. Just make a tee time with the Golf Shop. Entry fee is \$5.00 per team. Come out on Friday afternoon and have some FUN! Teams can be 2 men, 2 ladies or 1 man & 1 lady. The event will be flighted by scores.

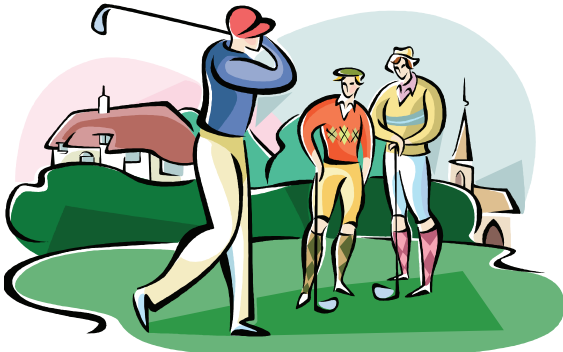

8-Person One Club Alternate Shot

Saturday, June 19 / Tee Times start at 3:00pm

18 Holes of Fun Golf



Entry Fee: \$5.00 per person / cart fee extra

Team Format: 8-person alternate shot

Format Requirements: The 8 player team must rank each player as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8.

Player #1 tees off on hole #1 and one ball is alternated for the entire 18 holes. Each player must hit in the proper order as they were designated. If player #5 holes out on hole #1 then player #6 must tee off on hole #2. Each of the 8 players **MUST** pre-select a club that they will use and they must use only that club when it is their turn to hit, no matter where they are hitting from.

All putts MUST be holed out, no exceptions.

This is what makes this format fun and exciting.

Tee times will be on the sign up sheet. They go in 5 minute intervals.

Sign up on the bulletin board by Friday, June 18 as a team or an individual.
