Memorial Day 5 Player Scramble

Monday, May 30, 2011 / 8:00am shotgun start

This event will be a 5 player best position scramble format. The event is open to men & women golf members only. The A & B players will play best position and the C, D, E players will play best position. The two scores combined on each hole will be the team score. The golf committee will do the pairings for each team, no special requests, please. The golf committee will make every effort to keep the teams as fair as possible as most teams will be a mix of men and women.

1. Please sign up by calling the Golf Shop or sign up on the bulletin board. ENTRIES accepted through Saturday, May 28th. This will give the committee time to get the pairings finished and the event set up for Monday play. The cost per person is \$35.00 which includes: buffet breakfast, buffet lunch & prizes. Carts charges are extra. All prizes will be returned in EPGC Gift Cards.
2. **NOTE:** There will be a 1:30pm shotgun start for all other regular member play on Monday. Please call the Golf Shop to make a starting hole assignment for the 1:30pm shotgun.

Women's & Men's Day Rules

TUESDAY - LADIES DAY: The first tee will be reserved for morning Ladies League activities from 7:00am - 10:00am, May through September and for the Evening Ladies League play from 4:00pm - 6:00pm, May through August. Both leagues have the right to close the entire course for special events. Play on the back nine will be allowed provided there is no cross over interference from front nine play and a significant distance is established from Ladies League play. **NOTE:** The Evening Ladies League starts play on the back nine on the last Tuesday of each month from May through August.

THURSDAY - MEN'S DAY: From May 1st through September 30th, Ladies are allowed morning play only. Ladies tee times should be scheduled to insure that play is completed on the front nine by 11:00am and all ladies shall be completely off the golf course by 1:00pm.

The entire course may be closed for special men's events. **EXCEPTION:** Ladies may be allowed on the course after the times mentioned above, as *spectators only* to watch club sanctioned events.

Hole-in-One Rules

Simply stated: If you get a hole-in-one and have insurance, the insurance will buy one drink for anyone in your foursome (regardless of whether or not they have insurance) and anyone on the premises who owns hole-in-one insurance **AT** the time of the hole-in-one.

Reciprocal: You have probably heard some rumors that we are involved with some other golf clubs in a reciprocity agreement. The final details have been worked out and we are exchanging with Arrowhead C.C. (near Chillicothe) and Lake Bracken C.C. (near Galesburg). We can play either course Tuesday through Friday for \$15.00 which includes the cart fee. You must call for tee times. Identify yourself as an EPGC member and take your handicap card with you. If you didn't buy a handicap you can borrow a card from the Golf Shop.

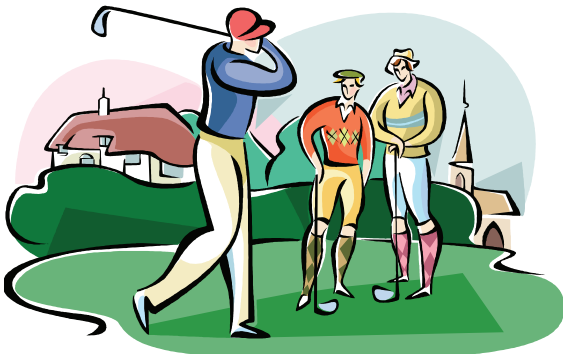
